**REGULATIONS
OF THE 8TH CHILDREN OF ASIA
INTERNATIONAL SPORTS GAMES**

Yakutsk, the Sakha Republic (Yakutia)
Russian Federation

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games are conducted in accordance with the decision of the Children of Asia International Committee by №VM/18 dated from December 30, 2021 with the aim of promoting ideas of the Olympic Movement, development of children and youth sports and strengthening of international sports cooperation as stated in the Concept of the Children of Asia International Sports Games approved by the Children of Asia International Committee, the Contractual framework for hosting the 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games in 2024 signed January 27, 2022 between the Head of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) and the Children of Asia International Committee, the Agreement on preparation and holding the 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games (hereinafter referred to as the Games) between the Children of Asia International Committee and the Autonomous non-profit organization "Directorate for preparation and holding the 8th summer Children of Asia International Sports Games".

The main objectives of the Games are:

- strengthening of friendship between children of the countries of the Asian continent;
- enhancing of sports mastery;
- revealing of the most skilled athletes for the national Olympic team reserves of the countries of the Asian Continent and the Russian Federation;
- development and promotion of physical culture and sports;
- development and popularization of traditional sports of the peoples of the Asian continent.

II. VENUE AND DATES

The Games are held on **June 25 – July 7, 2024** in Yakutsk, the Sakha Republic (Yakutia), Russian Federation.

Day of arrival – **June 25, 2024**. Day of departure – **July 7, 2024**.

III. ORGANIZERS OF THE GAMES

The organizers of the Games on the territory of the Russian Federation are the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation, the Government of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) of the Russian Federation with the support of the Russian Olympic Committee and the Children of Asia International Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Committee).

The direct holding of the Games is entrusted to the Regional Organizing Committee for preparation and holding of the Games (hereinafter referred to as the Organizing Committee), approved by order of the Head of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) dated April 5, 2022 No. 226-RG, Autonomous

non-profit organization "Directorate for preparation and holding the 8th summer Children of Asia International Sports Games" (hereinafter referred to as the Authorized organization), the Chief Referee Board of the Games confirmed by the Committee and approved by the Organizing Committee.

IV. REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPANTS AND TERMS OF THEIR ADMISSION

United teams of the member countries of the Olympic Council of Asia, countries and regions located on the Asian continent (the Republic of Azerbaijan, the Republic of Armenia, Georgia, the Republic of Turkey) (hereinafter referred to as the Countries of the Asian Continent), Far Eastern, Siberian and Ural Federal Districts of the Russian Federation, and two united teams of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) are admitted for the Games.

In accordance with intergovernmental agreements signed with the Government of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia), united teams of the Republic of Bashkortostan, the Republic of Tatarstan and the City of Moscow of the Russian Federation are allowed to participate in the Games, as well as united team of Ancient Olympia of Greece as provided by the twinning agreement between Ancient Olympia and Yakutsk. In accordance with the decision of the Children of Asia International Committee's Board dated May 2, 2023 № VM/31 the united team of the Republic of Belarus is admitted for the Games.

Formation of the united teams from the Countries of the Asian Continent is carried out by the National Olympic Committee and/or the national authority responsible for the development of children and youth sports of the applicant country.

Formation of the united teams from federal districts and regions of the Russian Federation is implemented based on results of official competitions held in accordance with the Unified calendar plan of interregional, All-Russian, and international sports events approved by the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation.

Executive authority for the development of children and youth sports is responsible for the formation of the united teams from regions of the Russian Federation.

Management for the formation of the united teams from federal districts of the Russian Federation is implemented by designated persons appointed by the Ministry of Sports of Russia.

Age of participants – 16 years and younger (born in 2008 and younger).

For each sport, the age of the participants is determined by the competition regulations in accordance with the current rules approved by the relevant international sports federation. Regulations are approved by the Organizing Committee upon agreement with the Committee and All-Russian Federation in corresponding sport.

Membership of the participants in the united teams from federal districts and regions of the Russian Federation is determined by their registration in respective region (federal district) or participation may be granted subject to the availability of the confirming documents (extract from the order of admission) on membership in physical culture and sports organization of region (federal district) represented, issued no later than September 1, 2023.

Membership of the participants in the united teams from foreign countries is determined in accordance with their citizenship.

Competitions in team sports (3x3 basketball, volleyball, mini football (futsal)) will be held among united teams of the Countries of the Asian Continent, united teams of Far Eastern, Siberian and Ural Federal Districts of the Russian Federation, and one united team of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia).

Maximum number of participants of the united teams from Far Eastern, Siberian, Ural federal districts of the Russian Federation and the second team of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) in individual sports excluding demonstration sports (alysh, rock climbing) must not exceed 110 athletes. Including team sports: basketball (sport discipline "3x3 basketball"), volleyball, football (sport discipline "mini football (futsal)") must not exceed 154 athletes. The composition of the united teams in each sport is to be formed in accordance with Appendix 1 to these Regulations.

Maximum number of participants of the united teams from the Republic of Bashkortostan, the Republic of Tatarstan and the City of Moscow in individual sports excluding demonstration sports (alysh, rock climbing) must not exceed 73 athletes. The composition of the united teams in each sport is to be formed in accordance with Appendix 2 to these Regulations.

Number of coaches and other specialists of the united teams in individual sports must not exceed the following numbers related to the declared number of athletes: up to 4 athletes – 1 coach/specialist, from 5 to 9 athletes – up to 2 coaches/specialists, from 10 to 14 athletes – up to 3 coaches/specialists.

Participants must have their sports equipment and uniform.

For team sports, participants must have two sets of uniforms (different in color).

Official members of delegations and athletes must be provided with unified sports outfits.

United teams must have unified sports outfits with the name of the team. Teams can use the Game's logo on sports uniforms and equipment in compliance with the requirements to brand identity of the Games.

It is not permitted to use as the team's name words unrelated to the name of the united team.

The draw for team sports is carried out by the Committee together with the Organizing Committee no later than June 12, 2024.

The exact schedule of competitions in sports included in the program of the Games will be specified in the competition regulations for each sport separately.

Competitions in sports will be held according to acting rules approved by international sports federations in corresponding sports (hereinafter referred to as the Sports Rules).

Appeals and protests on competition results are considered in accordance with rules of competitions by the board of appeals in each sport (in exceptional cases – by the Chief Referee Board of the Games).

Disputable issues on general matters are considered by the Organizing Committee of the Games.

Protests and appeals should be submitted in written form by team representatives or heads of delegations in accordance with the Sports rules.

In competitions of team sports (3x3 basketball, volleyball, mini football (futsal) competition balls are provided by the Organizing Committee of the Games.

Referees within teams from foreign countries must have acting international referee categories.

VI. SPORTS. GENERAL REGULATIONS

In each individual discipline, the team has the right to nominate athletes in accordance with the regulations for holding competitions in a sport (sports discipline).

In team competitions and relay races, athletes are allowed in accordance with the Sports Rules.

The sports qualification of participants in each sport is determined by the rules of the competition in accordance with the current rules approved by the international sport federation.

ARCHERY

Team composition – 9 persons, including:

boys – 3 persons

girls – 3 persons

coaches and other specialists – no more than 2 persons

team representative – 1 person

Age of participants: 16 years and younger (01.01.2008 and younger).

Individual (qualification and finals) and mixed team competitions in classic bow 60 m.

The winners are determined based on the results of the final rounds.

– Classic bow 60 m (36+36 shots) + finals

– Classic bow 60 m mixed team (qualification + finals 60 m)

– Classic bow 60 m team (qualification + finals 60 m)

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

ATHLETICS

Team composition – 33 persons, including:

boys – 13 persons

girls – 13 persons

coaches and other specialists – no more than 6 persons.

team representative – 1 person

Age of participants: 14-15 years (U16) (01.01.2009 - 31.12.2010).

Athletes aged 13 years (01.01.2011-31.12.2011) are allowed to the competitions on presentation of a doctor's permit, parental and coach permission to compete.

For each event a team can apply for no more than two participants.
Competitions in 100 m race, 200 m race, hurdles 100 m, hurdles 110 m are held in two circles (preliminary races and the final). In other race events the final races are held. In technical disciplines, depending on the number of participants declared for the events, qualifying competitions can be held. For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

BASKETBALL **(sport discipline “3x3 basketball”)**

Team composition – 11 persons, including:
boys – 4 persons
girls – 4 persons
coaches and other specialists – no more than 2 persons.
Team representative - 1 person.
Age of participants – 13-16 years (01.01.2008-31.12.2011).

The tournament will host 1 team of boys and 1 team of girls from each of the Countries of the Asian Continent, Far Eastern, Siberian and Ural Federal Districts of the Russian Federation and the Sakha Republic (Yakutia).
For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

BOXING

Team composition – 23 persons, including:
boys – 12 persons (one athlete per weight category)
girls – 5 persons (one athlete per weight category)
coaches and other specialists – no more than 5 persons.
Team representative – 1 person
Competitions are individual.
Age of participants: 15-16 years (01.01.2008-31.12.2009).
Weight categories:
boys: 44-46, 48, 50, 52, 54, 57, 60, 63, 66, 70, 75, 80 kg.
girls: 44-46, 50, 52, 54, 57 kg.
For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

CHESS

Team composition – 7 persons, including:
boys – 2 persons
girls – 2 persons
coaches and other specialists – no more than 2 persons.
team representative – 1 person
Age of participants: 16 years and younger (01.01.2008 and younger).
Competitions are held in the format of a personal tournament (separately among boys and girls) in Swiss system in 9 rounds.
Time control: 1 hour 30 minutes for each participant until the end of the game with an addition of 30 seconds for each move starting from the first.
Winners are determined by the highest number of points scored. In case of equality of points, places are determined by the truncated Buchholz coefficient, then by the Buchholz coefficient, then by a personal meeting, in case of equality of all three indicators - Armageddon.

DANCE SPORT

Team composition – 9 persons, including:
Sport discipline “Couples”:
Couple (1 boy, 1 girl)
Sport discipline “Breaking”:
boys – 1 person
girls – 1 person

coaches and other specialists – no more than 4 persons.

team representative – 1

Age of participants:

Sport discipline “Couples”:

14-15 years (01.01.2009 - 31.12.2010)

In sport discipline “Couples” one partner of a couple may be younger than it is determined in age group, but not more than for 4 years.

Sport discipline “Breaking”:

13-15 years (01.01.2009-31.12.2011)

Program of competitions:

- Couples – 10 Dance: Waltz, Tango, Viennese Waltz, Slow Foxtrot, Quickstep, Samba, Cha-Cha-Cha, Rumba, Paso Doble, Jive.
- “breaking” (b-boys) 1vs1
- “breaking” (b-girls) 1vs1
- “breaking crew” (mixed team b-boys, b-girls) 2vs2.

Teams are formed from participants in solo nominations.

For the united teams from foreign countries in sports discipline “Couples” additional 1 referee is allowed.

FOOTBALL **(sport discipline “mini football (futsal)”)**

Team composition – 16 persons, including:

boys - 12 persons.

coaches and other specialists – no more than 3 persons.

Team representative – 1 person

Age of participants: 14-16 years (01.01.2008-31.12.2010).

Teams are divided into groups depending on number of participants.

Teams qualified from the group play for elimination according to the cup system.

The competition system subject to change depending on the number of teams.

1 team of boys from each of the Countries of the Asian Continent, Far Eastern, Siberian and Ural Federal Districts of the Russian Federation, and the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) participates in the tournament.

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

GO

Team composition - 7 persons, including:

boys - 2 persons

girls - 2 persons

coaches and other specialists - no more than 2 people

team representative - 1 person

Age of participants: 12-15 years (01.01.2009-31.12.2012)

Competitions are held in the format of individual, doubles, team tournaments according to the Swiss system in 5-6 rounds.

Time control: 1 hour for each participant until the end of the game + byo-yomi 30 sec. per move (3 periods). Winners are determined by the highest number of points scored. In case of equality of points, places are determined by the Berger coefficient, then by the Buchholz coefficient, then by the personal meeting.

JUDO

Team composition – 22 persons, including:

boys – 9 persons (one athlete per weight category)

girls – 8 athletes (one athlete per weight category)

coaches and other specialists – no more than 4 persons.

team representative - 1 person

Age of participants – 15-16 years (01.01.2008-31.12.2009).

girls: 40, 44, 48, 52, 57, 63, 70, over 70 kg.

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

KHAPSAGAI

Competitions are individual and conducted according to the current rules approved by the Khapsagai Wrestling Federation of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia).

boys: 45, 50, 55, 62, over 62 kg.

KICKBOXING

Team composition: 10 persons, including:

boys - 7 people (one athlete per weight category)

coaches and other specialists - no more than 2 persons

team representative - 1 person

Age of participants: 15-16 years (01.01.2008-31.12.2009)

Competitions are individual, held in the ring discipline:

"low kick"

Weight categories:

boys: 45, 48, 51, 54, 57, 60, 63.5 kg.

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

KURASH

Competitions are held according to the current rules approved by the International Kurash Association (IKA).

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

MAS-WRESTLING

Team composition – 8 persons, including:

boys – 5 persons (one athlete per weight category)

coaches and other specialists – no more than 2 persons

team representative – 1 person

Age of participants: 14-15 years (01.01.2009-31.12.2010)

Competitions are individual, held according to the current rules approved by the International Mas-Wrestling Federation with elimination after two defeats.

boys: 50, 60, 70, 80, over 80 kg.

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS

- Mixed doubles

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

TAEKWONDO (WTF)

Team composition – 15 persons, including:

boys – 5 persons (one athlete per weight category)

girls – 5 athletes (one athlete per weight category)

coaches and other specialists – no more than 4 persons

team representative – 1 person

Age of participants: 15-16 years (01.01.2008-31.12.2009).

Competitions are held according to the Olympic system (two third places).

Age of participants: 14-15 years (01.01.2009-31.12.2010)

Competitions are held in freestyle in the following weight categories:

boys: 50, 55, 60, 65, 70 kg.

girls: 40, 45, 50, 55 kg.

Competitions are held according to the current rules approved by World Alysh Federation (WAF)

ROCK CLIMBING

(demonstration sport)

Team composition - 9 persons, including:

boys - 3 persons

girls - 3 persons

coaches and other specialists - no more than 2 persons

team representative - 1 person

Age of participants: 14-15 years old (01.01.2009-31.12.2010).

Competitions are held in the following sports disciplines:

- lead (boys, girls)
- speed (boys, girls)
- bouldering (boys, girls)

VII. CULTURAL PROGRAM

For the cultural program within the framework of the Games, teams are recommended to prepare several amateur performances (single or group dance, folk song, choral performance, various acrobatic and comic performances, playing musical instruments, etc.).

VIII. CONDITIONS OF RESULTS

The Games' competitions include:

- individual championship;
- team championship in team sports.

Winners in individual and team championships in sports are determined according to the rules of holding competitions in relevant sports and regulations of sport competitions.

The Games are held without determining general team place.

IX. AWARDING

The winners of 1-3 places in individual sports disciplines are awarded with medals, diplomas and memorable prizes from the Organizing Committee.

The winners of 1-3 places in team sports disciplines are awarded with cups, team members – with medals, diplomas and memorable prizes from the Organizing Committee.

Coaches of winners in individual and team sports disciplines, and winning teams in team sports disciplines are awarded with medals and diplomas from the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee establishes additional prizes for team members.

X. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

Financial support for the costs of holding the Games is carried out on the basis of equity co-financing by the Ministry of Sport of the Russian Federation, the Government of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) and at the expense of funds raised from extrabudgetary sources.

Financial support for the costs of holding the Games is carried out by the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation at the expense of the federal budget allocations provided for by it in the federal law on the federal budget for the next financial year and planning period. Financial provision of expenses for holding the Games is carried out by the Government the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) at the expense of budgetary allocations provided for in the regional law on the regional budget for the next financial year and planning period.

The Ministry of Sports of Russia provides financial support for the Games in accordance with the Procedure for financing from the federal budget and the Norms for spending funds on holding physical culture and sports events (including significant international official sports events and sports events) included in the Unified calendar plan for interregional, all-Russian and international physical culture events and sports events.

Directions for spending these funds are determined according to the consolidated cost estimate for holding the Games.

Expenditures for delegating teams and participants to the Games (travel costs to and from the host city, daily allowances, insurance) are provided by the delegating organizations.

Meals and accommodation for participants are provided by the organizer of the Games at the expense of budgetary and non-budgetary sources.

The insurance of participants in the Games is carried out at the expense of the budgets of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation and extra-budgetary funds in accordance with the current legislation of the Russian Federation, as well as at the expense of the sending organization.

XI. SAFETY AND SECURITY OF TEAMS AND SPECTATORS

The safety of participants and spectators is ensured in accordance with the requirements of the Safety Rules for conduct of official sports competitions, approved by Decree of the Government of the Russian

Federation dated April 18, 2014 No. 353, as well as the requirements of the rules for sports included in the Games program.

The Games are held at sports facilities included in the All-Russian Register of Sports Facilities in accordance with Federal Law No. 329-FZ dated December 4, 2007 "On Physical Culture and Sports in the Russian Federation", in presence of acts of readiness of the sports facility for holding events approved in the established order.

The provision of emergency medical care is carried out in accordance with the order of the Ministry of Health of Russia dated October 23, 2020 No. 1144n

"On approval of the procedure for organizing the provision of medical care to persons involved in physical culture and sports (including in the preparation and conduct of physical culture and sports events), including the procedure for medical examination of persons wishing to undergo sports training, engage in physical culture and sports in organizations and (or) fulfill the test standards (tests) of the All-Russian physical culture and sports complex "Ready for Labor and Defense" (TRP) "and the forms of medical reports on admission to participate in physical culture and sports events."

Competitions are held in accordance with the regulations for organizing and holding official physical culture and sports events on the territory of the Russian Federation in the conditions of continued risks of the spread of COVID-19, approved by the Russian Ministry of Sports and Rospotrebnadzor (as amended and supplemented), as well as in accordance with the decision of the Chief State Sanitary Doctor of the Russian Federation dated June 20, 2022 No. 18 "On certain provisions of the resolutions of the Chief State Sanitary Doctor of the Russian Federation on issues related to the spread of a new coronavirus infection (COVID-19)".

XII. INSURANCE OF PARTICIPANTS

Participation of athletes in the Games is subject to the presence of the original copy of an insurance agreement: insurance from accidents and of life and health, which is presented to the Credentials Committee for each participant. All members of the sports delegation are subject to insurance.

Conditions of insurance related to organization of the Games are provided by the Agreement on preparation and holding of the 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games in 2024 signed between the Children of Asia International Committee and the Authorized organization.

XIII. APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION

The Committee sends to the participating countries and regions of the Russian Federation the forms of official, nominal and technical applications.

Confirmations (official entries) are submitted to the Committee no later than March 1, 2024 in accordance with Appendix 3 to these Regulations by the email address id@cagic.org.

Duly filled nominal entries in electronic form must be submitted to the Organizing Committee no later than June 1, 2024. Applications are filled in according to the established form (Appendix 4 to these Regulations).

On the day of arrival, team representatives submit the following documents to the Credentials Committee of the Games.

The united teams from federal districts and regions of the Russian Federation:

- technical applications in the prescribed form for each sport in two copies (Appendix 5 to these Regulations);

- birth certificate (participants under the age of 14);

- passport of the citizen of the Russian Federation or a substitute document proving the identity of the participant;

- consent to the processing of personal data (for each member of the delegation) (Appendix 6 to this Regulation);

- consent of parents to the processing of personal data of underage athletes (Appendix 6.1 to this Regulation);

- consent of the parents of underage athletes to participate in competitions (Appendix 6.2 to these Regulations);

- compulsory medical insurance policy of a citizen of the Russian Federation (for each member of the delegation) in the form of a document on a tangible medium or in the form of a bar code (graphic information in coded form);

- policy (agreement) of life and health insurance against accidents (for each member of the delegation);

- information about preventive vaccinations carried out within the framework of the national calendars of the participating countries;

- a medical certificate (original copy) with admission to competitions, for participants in boxing competitions - a boxer's passport (IBA).

The united teams from foreign countries:

- technical applications in the prescribed form for each sport in two copies (Appendix 5 to these Regulations);

- passport or a substitute document proving the identity of the participant;

- policy (agreement) of life and health insurance against accidents (for each member of the delegation);
